The Beginning in Palm Springs

Ocotillo Lodge

- + Completed late 1957, sold August 1958
- + William Krisel's archive suggests destination resort concept
- Prior to Ocotillo Lodge, George and Mildred lived in LA's Sunset Towers
- → The Desert Sun, February 1958:
 - Candlewood Wine Tasting Society event attended by Mr. and Mrs. Harry James, Rock Hudson, Rhonda Fleming, Liberace, Hugh O'Brian, Mr. and Mrs. Errol Flynn, Alan Ladd, and Groucho and Zeppo Marx

Twin Palms Estates

- → Twin Palms Estates #1 Tract Map is dated August 1955
- + First completed Alexander neighborhood in Palm Springs
 - Duane Tjomsland was foreman
- + Robert, Helene, and Jill Alexander
 - Lived on Apache Circle

Twin Palms Estates

- + Joseph Charles Dunas
 - Lived on Apache Circle
 - ♦ Partner of George Alexander
 - ♦ Wrote self-help book Joy For Daily Living in 1966
 - In mid 50s, Palmer & Krisel designed Dunas family homes in Brentwood
- + Thorwald Christian Fredericksen
 - Movie Picture Studio Contractor
- + Thorwald Courtland Fredericksen
- + Thorwald Fredericksen III


Ramon Rise Estates (aka Little Beverly Hills)

- Krisel project logbook lists Ramon Rise Estates prior to Twin Palms Estates
- + January 1956: JC Dunas commissions Palmer & Krisel floorplan for 63 sites acquired pre 1956
- Built 1957/1958 using January 1957
 Palmer & Krisel floorplan
 - Later used in Sunmor Estates and Vista Las Palmas



Ramon Rise Estates (aka Little Beverly Hills)

- + ACC homes marketed as "Enchanted Village"
- + Five elevations
 - Suburba, Fiesta, Fleetwood, Enchantment, El Dorado
- + Sales price of \$18,500

Own Your Neighborhood History

- → The Alexanders: A Desert Legacy
 - ♦ Author, James R. Harlan
 - Cites 84 Alexanders in Ramon Rise, but
 - ♦ Building permits indicate only 63 Alexanders
 - Other 21 were built earlier by George Goldberg, Samuel Sontag and Jack Meiselman
- + Jack and Bernie Meiselman
 - Mistakenly described as brothers
 - ♦ Bernie is actually Berne (Bernice) Meiselman, Jack's wife
